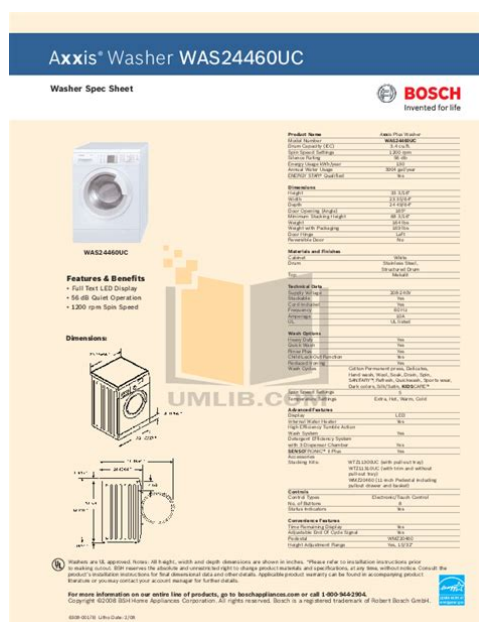

The dryer version of this product is equally bad. If I were a German engineer, I would be embarrassed. To add insult to injury, Bosch customer service does not care about their customers. And then there are the very expensive parts. Bottom line. don't buy Bosch products. I now understand why my appliance repairman of 30 years told me that he won't service Bosch products and he wished me good luck in finding a repairman who would not take me to the cleaners. Shame on Bosch! I purchased my Bosch machine last July 2010 and it broke at the end of December. It is now April and I still am stuck with a washer that doesn't work. We have had factory service repairmen in on four occasions now. Each time they come they can't fix it and tell me they need to order another part.

Ordering a part takes several days, then you have to wait several days to schedule an appointment. In our most recent appointment, the repairman pretty much admitted that it was unlikely the next part was going to fix it, but he wasn't authorized to do anything more until he tried. This cycle is unending and my time and inconvenience does not seem to matter to anyone. When I call Bosch customer service, they are not helpful and so far have been unwilling to replace the machine despite months without a working machine and multiple repair visits. I am likely going to have to just buy a new washer. It certainly will not be Bosch. I have owned this machine since 2010. Five years later I have had three service calls and this would be the fourth if I were to have it repaired. Rather than wasting my money on this again I will take a sledge hammer to the darn thing. It failed two weeks after we had it installed, computer issue. It was on factory warranty. OK. A year and half later the pump stopped working. They charged us for the second visit replace the pump and had to return again because they did not install it correctly. Wanted to charge us again but I promised I would contact state better business bureau. The pump failed again in one year. For reference we are empty nesters, use the machine 23 times a week light loads. It just a piece of junk. When I started having problems with it I found help online and only had a service person out once. When it overflowed it was a major issue. Now I have a little frog that will squeal if the floor is wet. Very high tech; The best thing is the size. It was the only set at the time that would fit in the only closet with plumbing access. After the leak, I put down waterproof sheeting then some heavy duty rubber the kind you see in commercial gyms along with tiles. So when it shakes, rattles and rolls, I don't worry about the whole thing jumping out of the closet. Don't try to use this for more than a small load of wash.

I found out that most appliance repair people around here won't work on the Bosch machines anymore. I guess it is hard to get parts. So before you buy this check that out. The dryer like most new dryers doesn't really fully dry the clothes. Invest in a drying rack. When the washer won't drain or spin out enough water. Ultimately a time out for these is akin to kicking it. I would not buy another one even as a secondary laundry. Keep shopping. Given a do over I would remodel the house before I would replace these! YUCK! I hate them! I put a lightweight, small throw blanket in with other laundry and, though it spun just fine after the wash cycle, would not spin after the rinse cycle. I ended up having to take the blanket out and let it drip all over my deck, while I spun the rest of the laundry. The dryer is one of the weakest dryers I've ever had. It takes an hour and twenty minutes to

fully dry a load. The washer smells terrible and stinks up the clothes in spite of the fact that I leave both the door and the detergent add door open for hours after every load, and I prop them open with a rolled up cloth all the rest of the time. The fabric softener slot stays full of water and doesn't drain. It often unbalances in a standard load spin cycle and shakes the entire house. I could wash dog beds, sleeping bags, and anything else in my Maytags previously. Now I have to go to a laundromat to wash anything out of the ordinary. I've never been so sorry that I bought something in my entire life. And to think I retired my terrific toploading Maytags because my husband was sure we should have front loaders. I could have done this latest wash quicker if I had done it by hand and hung it on the line. I complained to them about various problems early on and they never responded, much less do anything about it. There is no doubt that eye diagrams can help in teaching data in the classroom. Statistics can be difficult for a great deal of students and a number of them do not know it.

However, if one uses the eye diagram method, then they're better able to see what is going on and more importantly understand what's going on. What this means is that you can have students look at different items to get a better understanding of how their brain processes visual input. To use an eye diagram, students first glance at either the left or right eye. They then turn their head on the side so that the image appears like it's either looking directly at them or in the wall behind them. After this they return to their left eye and close their eye. Students then adhere to the eye line to a stage at which they're taking a look at the wall. If the pupil looks down to his left, then they're looking at the wall. The instructor has the professor assumes that pupils are looking at the ground. This can be very effective because it's easy to visually generate visual input which allows pupils to work out exactly what's going on in their brain. It also has an Extra Hot setting which only works with heavy duty. I don't agree with Mr. Conecaster who's constantly singing praises about his on-demand water heater at all. Matter of fact, today I just got my new tank heater that I picked up yesterday into the basement. My friend is going to do the swap for me hopefully next week. The on-demand water heater sitting on my basement wall right now is a Bosch AquaStar Model GWH 2700 ES LP, that is it's powered by propane, installed in February 2009 by the builder of my house. I paid extra for it, a lot extra a tank heater would have been a no extra cost item in the house build. It was never good, never mind great. But since I had heard all the stuff about these water heaters it must have just been me, right. I was NEVER able to set the water temperature to what I wanted while showering. That tap has a single handle so of course full hot would be selected as described. If washing a glass or dish I'd adjust the tap to comfortable on the hands temperature, less than hot. Whatever they suggested I did. I had the plumbing altered per their suggestion to install a backwash line. Real long story shorter, I've spent a fair bit of hard-earned on this item. The builder has nothing to do with any of this since any new house warranty had long expired by the

time I figured I was going to sort this out. I won't bother describing that experience but you all can use your imaginations about trying to talk to a human at some outfit that's spent big bucks to try to make that as difficult as possible. Suffice to say they were no help at all, but I did get a customer number. No one carries Bosch around here any more. No one. I was considering another brand of these things, ones that required less flow to activate the heater since I thought that might be the problem, when I heard the strangest thing.

I don't know what the person that said that were the last ones that still use tanks is talking about. My wife suggested we just change to the brand of ondemand heater at Home Depot with their warranty etc. And for conecasters advice. I'm done with throwing good money after bad. After all wasn't simplicity one of the ondemand water heaters selling points. Think about it for three seconds. Tank rupturing. You've got to be kidding me if you think I'm going to worry about that. To my mind that's a nonissue. If no luck with that I'm going to use it for target practice. Sorry about the novella..See More Best Dishwasher Detergent. Q Comments 135 for diyher. I had a stainless steel travel mug and tried putting it in the dishwasher, and it filled with water between the outside and inside wall of the cup and leaked all over my counter when I took it out of the dishwasher. Same soaking principle works on them..See More Thoughts on the new Bosch Benchmark appliances Q Comments 83 Perhaps the most significant difference between the Benchmark dual fuel range and the 800 series is when you use propane instead of natural gas. On both units, the heat output of the right front burner drops from 15K BTU to 13.5K BTUs, which is notable if not huge. However, on the power burner in the center, the output drops from 18K to 12.5K yikes! on the 800 series, yet on the Benchmark it drops only from 20K to 17K with propane. So the Benchmark gives you a very decent if not awesome power burner even with propane, while the 800 series gives you just one relatively anemic 13.5 burner as your most powerful option. True, the Benchmark includes a sliding oven rack and softclose door, but those bells are irrelevant to me. It got excellent reviews for performance and reliability and has four 19K burners, even with propane. True, the oven is gas and not selfcleaning, but that's a trade off I'm OK with.

Moreover, the electronic panel on the Bosch seems vulnerable being so close to the oven door and susceptible to the intense heat of a selfcleaning cycle..See More Bosch oven door glass shattered during self clean Q Comments 72 It's been awhile since I read up on it but from what I recall that there is pretty much one glass manufacturer that makes the glass for a majority of ovens and it is the glass and not the oven directly causing the problem. For some reason I don't know why but Bosch seems to have the most complaints. Perhaps it is the most popular oven sold in that price point. As you mentioned this shattering has been going on for some time and I'm kind of surprised that an Attorney hasn't gotten involved and filed a class action suit. I don't have a recommendation for a specific brand to replace it with. I have no answer for your 3rd party situation. I purchase appliances from locally owned stores that have their inhouse service departments so that if I do have any issues then I'm dealing with one entity. Also, if I'm allowed to I like to go pick the service departments brain on brands to see what their likes and dislikes are. They have no skin in the game so to speak of like the salesperson so they are more than happy usually to share their knowledge! This machine only has 4 temperatures as far as I can see cold, warm, hot, extra hot. How come they are quoting all this different numbers. Are these the temperatures you get if you do not select a temperature manually. Can you do such a thing select a program but not a temperature I asked the same questions you are asking and I agree it sounds confusing. I'm so glad you asked the question thanks. I was wondering the same thing myself as I have been using the machine for a few weeks but never got around to calling. You wash on Perm Press and it gives you 95 degree water.



Dark colors is 86, etc. But this machine does a great job. I do really like it a lot. But I guess this is all we get. Thanks for your help. That won't get anything clean without a ton of chemicals. I just purchased this washer, has not arrived yet. I am starting to worry a little. I also own the Miele W4840 and it is a very logical machine. Temps on the Miele are 2070C in 10c steps that you can manually select. Very logical. The old WFK2401 that died had a simple wash knob that went from cold to power temp boost. I could select the temp I wanted. There is no 100, 110 or 120 degree cycle. Really I personally consider warm to be around 110 degrees, very warm around 125-130, hot around 150 and sanitary somewhere between 170 and 210F. But this is also the best way to assure a moldy future to the machine. Also almost everybody leave the door with the latch not engaged almost close. That small gap is enough to avoid mold. There is need to keep the door totally open it's also annoying. Warm washes are weighted most heavily in determining Modified Energy Factor. So reducing the warm temperature helps achieve a lower MEF. In turn, lower MEF helps the manufacturer qualify for tax credits. And since we've all been led to believe or at least allowed to believe that these temperature reductions are federally mandated, we've gone along with it. Bosch essentially eliminated the ability to do any type of wash with water temps between 93F and 127F because of tax breaks. Do we get to blame Bosch when people use more bleach which is terrible for the environment due to the lousy water temps I just wish I could justify the cost of the Miele W3033. At least Miele has a custom cycle that will let you have the wash temps that you really want. In my state the W3033 would qualify for a 15% instant rebate. I got very nervous when I saw that their Miele showroom was being remodeled and the W3033 was no longer on display. We really do love it.

I have a chance to buy one of these at an absurdly low price. If the dual temp settings is a range, why is the large number first. Somewhere in this PDF, there should have been an explanation of the two figures. Because I'm still confused over this. Will the internal heater increase the temp to selected cycles associated temp regardless of the incoming temp. If not, how many degrees above the incoming temp can it increase. Is it 1350 watts Miele's looking better! Is it 1350 watts It draws 12 amps at 240V. I don't know why some of their brochures list the heater as 1350w; that appears to be incorrect, and would make the 240V electrical requirement pointless. The tag was meant to be placed on another item. Also, the Bosch weighs about 150 lbs, the Miele about 250 !! But the build quality on the Miele looks leagues ahead, and the controls are so much more straightforward. No inscrutable cycle names that leave you guessing as to what the machine will do. Sportsweat. I just wish it fit more easily in the space I have. Now I wish I still had it. It may be based on an Asko pair in our house. With those, I can set the temperature where I want it for each load. It's lukewarm. Also, when I touch the glass during cycles they told me use hotter water, the glass is waaaaay hotter than 127. Will the internal heater increase the water temp to the selected cycles associated temp regardless of the incoming temp. If not, how many degrees above the incoming temp can it increase. My washer area is about 25 feet from the hot water heater. When I select a warm or hot cycle, room temp water will enter. I'm a bit concerned with this before I buy the Axxis. Don't use the eco button it turns off the heater. You could use only cold water and it will heat to the temp required for the cycle. Now that mystery temp is what I want to know.

If the owner's manual says you can connect the machine to just a cold water feed as they did a few years ago, it should heat up to the proper temperature since it would have to. There are some other brands that, at least on some settings, have a time limit that takes precedence over reaching the set temperature, but I don't think the Bosch is like that. The person answering was not only clueless about the product, she gave me different answers each time she went back to check. I mean seriously, how hard is it to put that information on a website. Tragic. It clears it up for me. Looking forward to getting the WAS24460UC, waiting for some type of SALE. It's an expensive machine. Thanks Mine says Made in Germany.
