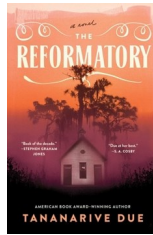

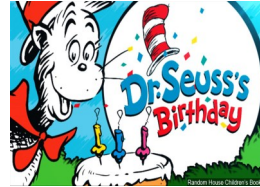

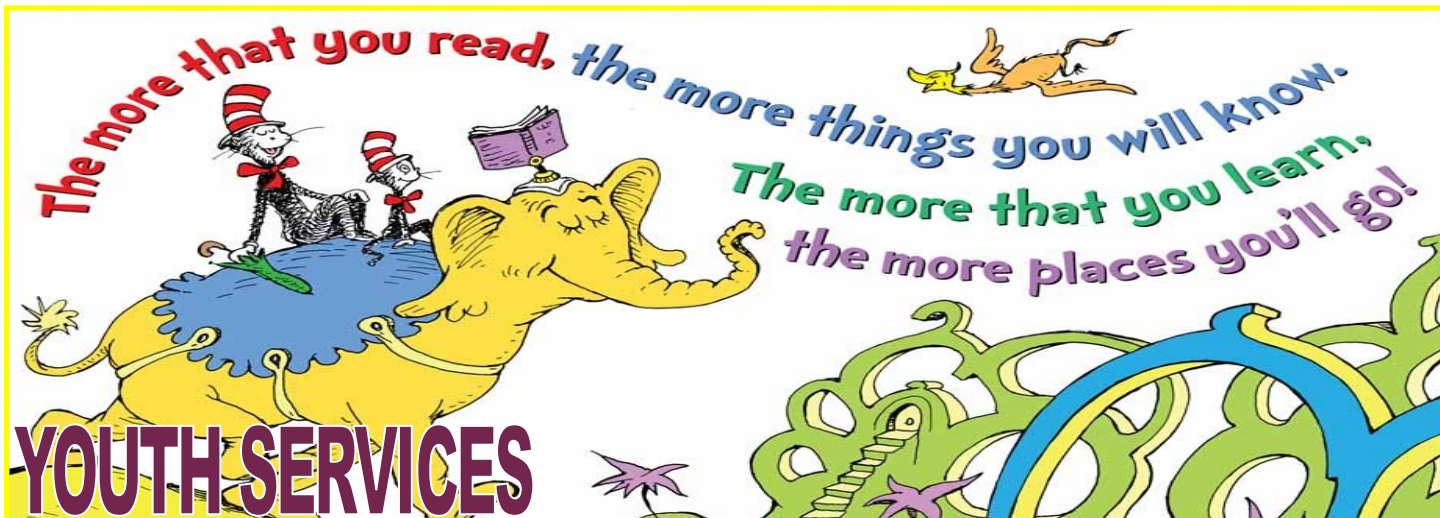

Join us for good reads, crafts, and treats.



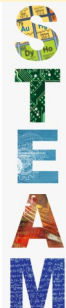

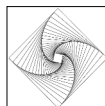

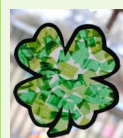
