The University Park Academic Scholarship Fund was formed by the Education Advisory Committee under the auspices of the University Park Village Board. **The Foundation provides financial awards to graduating high school seniors from University Park** who demonstrate academic ability, financial need, good general character, and a desire to attend college.

GOALS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM:

1. To provide financial assistance to deserving **University Park graduating high school seniors**.
2. To allow for the development of potential leaders from University Park.
3. To recognize high school graduating Seniors who have demonstrated service to the school, community, or church, as well as good academic ability and a financial need.

PROCEDURES FOR APPLYING:(MUST HAVE ALL 4 TO BE CONSIDERED)

1. Complete the scholarship application.
2. Attach a high school transcript or statement signed by the high school counselor showing GPA.
3. On a separate sheet of paper, write in your own style, using your own words, the answers to the following questions:
 - a. Please tell us about yourself. How do you view yourself in terms of school) now and in the future?
 - b. What are your future goals?
 - c. Where do you think you need the most improvement (academic, social, personal, etc.)?
 - d. How would you benefit from a University Park scholarship?

4. A LETTER (COPY) OF ACCEPTANCE FROM YOUR COLLEGE MUST BE ATTACHED TO YOUR APPLICATION or a letter from your parent/guardian stating the name(s) of the College or University you have applied to.
